

2010-2011 Yearbook Q & A

Q: How do I order?

A: All ordering is done online this year. No sending in checks or cash, no filling out papers and hoping they make it to the right people. Just go to <http://www.treering.com> , click REGISTER, type in **our school's code: 101285097800826** and get started.

Q: I don't have a computer or I don't want to order online. What do I do?

A: You can mail a check instead. Make check payable to: TreeRing Corporation
Include: School Name, Student Name, Teacher & Grade.

Mail to: TreeRing Co, 12668 E 116th St. #130, Fishers, IN 46037. They will notify the yearbook chairperson once your check has been received.

Q: The yearbook comes with two personalized pages. How do I do that?

A: Purchase your yearbook, then start the process of finding photos from this school year. Following TreeRing's easy steps to upload and create a "ring" of photos under your name. A customizable template is already set for you to drag & drop photos into, however with a few easy clicks of a mouse you can change background colors, wording, make photos larger or smaller, and add more photos to the page. You can delete text boxes or add more. It's truly yours to create. Or keep it simple and use the provided template.

Q: I see photos on the website from Halloween, school activities, the BMX assembly, and lots of other fun events. Can I use these?

A: YES! If you're seeing them, then they are available for use from the yearbook committee.

Q: I'm not interested in creating a customized page. Now what happens?

A: If you don't do a customized page, an alternate photo collage will be substituted in its place. You are under no obligation to create your own custom photo pages.

Q: I love this idea, and I have LOTS of photos of my child, their field trips, even their Art Corps artwork. Can I add MORE customizable pages to the 2 that come with the book?

A: YES! Each set of additional pages cost \$3.99. You'll find that info in the website.

Q: What are the deadlines and dates?

A: Sales deadline for all yearbooks is APRIL 13th, 2011. This is also the deadline for making your custom pages. So get organized now, purchase your book, upload your photos, and start having fun!

Q: I only buy one yearbook for the whole family to share. How will this work?

A: Choose one child's to place the order under. However, you can feel free to use any photos of all your students in the customizable section,

Q: I have lots of photos I've taken in my child's classroom. Can I upload them directly to TreeRing instead of submitting them to the yearbook person?

A: YES! That is an easy and fast way to share your photos. Just make sure you set them to be viewed by everyone and not just you. So the yearbook chairperson can use them in the book. You will see already established folders (called "rings") where you can put specific photos for that event.
